The **diminished triad** consists of two minor thirds. The frame interval (the two outer notes) forms a diminished fifth.



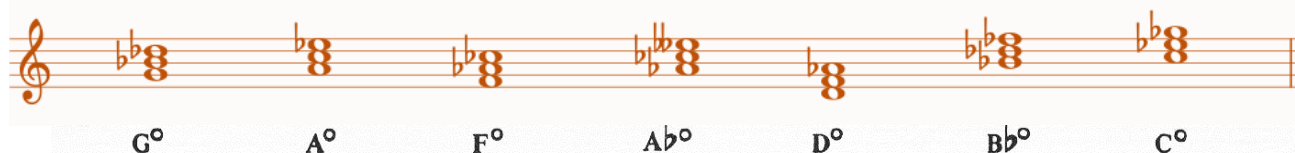
For the diminished triad, a small "zero" is added to the chord letter. (dim = diminished, e.g., C dim, or C[°]) This position is called the root position.
