

## LESSON 23

### DOTTED QUARTER NOTES (DOTTED CROTCHETS)



We know already that one dot adds half the value of the original note to the note value. In 4/4, 3/4 and 2/4 time signatures, a quarter note is one beat. A dot after a quarter note adds 1/2 beat (1/2 of the original value) to the note value. A dotted half note equals three quarter beats.



1. Add the missing bar lines.



2. Add the missing bar lines and name the notes.



3. Add the missing bar lines and name the notes



4. Write the beats/counts under the notes.



5. Some of the dotted quarter notes and rests have no dot. Complete the bars by completing the missing dots.
